Maybe we should forget about the New York Times for a while, and just read Jeremiah.

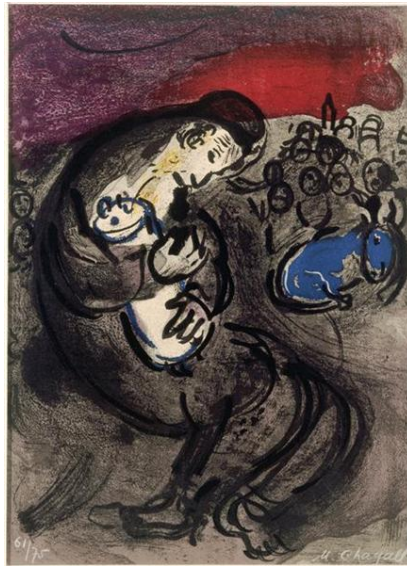
You'd be surprised how up-to-date he is.
