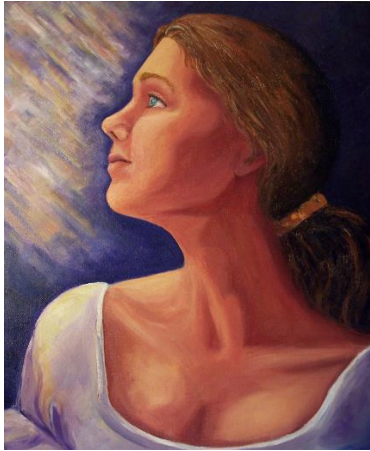


MY GOAL: THIS DAY
