Or with my life?

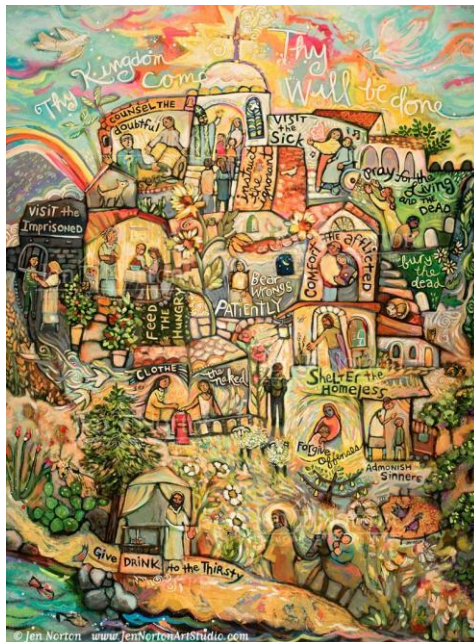
All things are possible to those who believe in Jesus with their life.
