"But of that day or that hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. Take heed, watch; for you do not know when the time will come. It is like a man going on a journey, when he leaves home and puts his servants in charge, each with his work, and commands the doorkeeper to be on the watch.

Watch therefore—for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or at cockcrow, or in the morning lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. And what I say to you I say to all: Watch."

Mark 13:32-37

Jesus describes to us signs of the End, things to alert us that the End is near.

---War, famine, earthquakes, suffering in increasing convulsions.

---Persecution, as the gospel begins its final spread over the earth.

---The Desolating Sacrilege---the Man of Sin.

---The Fig Tree.

But nothing will be clear until the Day arrives. And no one knows the day or the hour. Notice how Jesus commands us to be ready:


He does not pull out charts and graphs and show us details of how it will unfold.

He does not encourage us to "study Bible Prophecy." He simply says, "Watch!" i.e. Stay awake spiritually.

Do the work God gives you to do faithfully until the End arrives or until your end comes (death).

Do not be a prophecy speculator. Do not be a conspiracy theorist. Do not get side-tracked trying to anticipate what's coming next.

Be ready for his return by exercising the ministry you've been given.



Prayer-Yes Lord...we want to be ready for when you arrive. Inspire us, drive us, encourage us not to give up but to keep watching. Keep us awake. Keep us from being side-tracked. Keep us ready and doing whatever work that is before us until you arrive. Amen. Maranatha Mirror
