I will instruct you and teach you in the way that you should go. I will guide you with my eye.

Who of us is not in need of guidance from God?

Do I speak or hold my peace?

The counsel of every spiritual advisor and every Christian leader must be examined in the light that comes from the Lord Jesus.

Does it match his Spirit?

Is it driven by his care for all the forgotten ones, not just those in our own caste?

Does it stand up to the light of his truth?

"I am the light of the world; he who follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

John 8

The light of the Lord Jesus is the only light there is.

If we walk in his light, we will never be manipulated.
