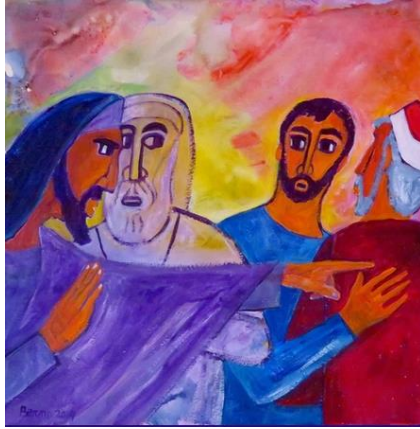


WHO'S UNDER JUDGEMENT?
