We cannot see it. Its ways are shrouded in mystery.


But when this fire falls...

The Cross

"I came to cast fire on the earth, and would that it were already kindled! I have a baptism to be baptized with, and how I am constrained until it is accomplished!"

Luke 12

Jesus of Nazareth bore the evil of the whole human race as he offered himself up at the cross. When the fire fell on him, the evil was consumed.







"Wait a minute!" you say, "If the fire of God consumed our sin at the Cross, how come we're still stumbling?"

The fire of the Cross begins to refine us only when we open our hearts to its heat.

Sooner or later God draws us each to the Cross and offers us the fire of divine cleansing.

"And I when I am lifted up from the earth (on the cross) will draw all people to myself."

John 12
