***Rejoice in the Lord always, and again I will say, rejoice!***

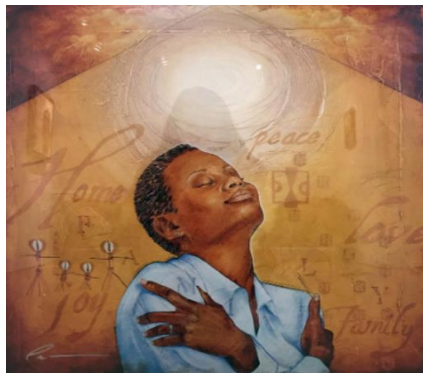
***Let all people know your forbearance.***
