John 15:6

He asks if we are walking in love, as he has commanded us.

If our love has grown cold, it's time to drop everything and seek help from the Master.

"As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you; abide in my love.

These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.

This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you."

If God's love is missing from our attitude toward people----<u>all people</u>--- our salvation is in question.

So we know and believe the love God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

I John 4:8,16
